I just noticed that the Charting Plugin page utilizes several little icons like this:

Note that "!" represents **required**, "-" represents **not required** and "+" represents **conditional**

Which are generated by this WML code:

Note that "(!)" represents **required**, "(-)" represents **not required** and "(+)" represents **conditional**

This is the first time I have seen these used... Are these listed in the documentation somewhere? Are there more of them? I would expect to see something like this listed in the ["Plain Text Markup Help" pop-up](#)
