Everytime I upgrade our clearspace installation with 2.0.0 or greater, I get the following template error when certain documents and other pages are loaded.

```
SEVERE: Error in template: <@ww.url action="embedded-doc-list" ><@www.param name="documentID">${document.documentID}
freemarker.core.ParseException: Error in template: <@ww.url action="embedded-doc-list" ><@www.param name="documentID">${
```

This error used to manifest catastrophically, and would prevent the entire page from loading.

In 2.0.3 it seems to be handled more elegantly, as seen in this screenshot.

However, once I created a new theme in the Admin console and set it as the global theme, the freemarker errors went away.
