Are there any plans on adding [transclusion](#) to documents? It appears that some in IT are using Wikimedia because this feature is not available in Clearspace. Of course, the way [wikimedia](#) does it is beyond most user's abilities. Perhaps there could be an easy visual way of including part of another document. For example, in the "Insert" feature there could be a document option. You could search for and view the document you want from within the modal window then select the text and click insert. Whenever the other document is changed it updates your document as well.
