In the admin console, it would appear as though you should be able to configure the report abuse setting per community, but it seems like you can only set this at a global level. Hey Kim-anh,

Abuse settings act globally and cannot be configured on a per-community basis. You can disable the flag that makes the form un-editable on the non-root communities, but the form will still reflect the global result for abuse settings.
